For rehabilitation projects, before and after images are preferred. The items will be retained, so make necessary copies before submittal. All images will become the property of the City of Montgomery for educational purposes only.

Nominations must be completed and delivered to Planning Controls at 25 Washington Avenue with all required attachments by April 6th but you can also complete a digital nomination form and send to canderson@montgomeryal.gov. Please include your name and contact information so we can make sure that all the nominators can be included in the celebration.

Awards will be presented at the regularly scheduled May Historic Preservation Commission meeting on Tuesday, May 8th at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Auditorium at City Hall.
